Request Deadline - Please fill out the form completely and submit by July 15, 2018, the deadline for classmate and session/weekday requests. After the deadline, no classmate requests can be honored and session/weekday requests will be honored as space allows. Enrollment forms are processed in the order they are received as long as your TBE Sacred Gift commitment and Temple account are current. If you need to make your Sacred Gift commitment, please contact [Candace Naliboff](#), Director of Member Services. **IMPORTANT** - There is no deadline for enrollment, only requests. We have room for every student!

Tuesday Religious School Option - The Tuesday Religious School class option is for 4th - 7th grade students who have conflicts with the Monday or Wednesday Religious School schedule for the entire school year or an extended period of time due to a sports season, school play or other long-term activity. Unfortunately, we are unable to offer this option for 3rd graders. This class will use a self-paced, independent study Hebrew/prayer curriculum. All classes will be led by a member of our Religious School faculty. There will be an additional \$100 class fee per year to attend this program due to low student:teacher ratio.
